



Rules Governing Students

1. Students are to be on time for all classes.
2. Students more than **15 minutes** late will not be allowed to take class. (They will be required to sit and watch the class)
3. Students will not be allowed to take classes if fees are not paid. (Fees are due on the first of each month or the beginning of each term)
4. Dance Bahamas will not be held responsible for items lost or stolen. Students are advised to leave personal items at home.
5. Students must remove street shoes before entering the studio.
6. Students are not allowed to eat in the waiting area, studio and the changing room.
7. There will be no GUM chewing.
8. All students must have their names printed on all dance attire.
9. Students must be properly attired for all classes, they are required to wear assigned class colours at all times. (Please refer to proper dance attire listed.)
10. Students with **RUNS or HOLES** in tights will not be allowed in class.
11. No jewellery is allowed in class; special permission will be granted for religious or medical reasons only.
12. Students must be properly groomed for classes. Girls with long hair must arrange their hair in a neat bun or tie in back neatly.
13. Students who are disruptive in class will be asked to sit on the side.
14. SMOKING is strictly prohibited.
15. Students must enter and leave the studio in a quiet and orderly manner.
16. Parents are asked to collect their child/children promptly after class. A **\$20** fee will be charged for the care and supervision of all students who remain on the premises 30 minutes after class has ended.
