

Rules Governing Students

- 1. Students are to be on time for all classes.
- 2. Students more than 15 minutes late will not be allowed to take class. (They will be required to sit and watch the class)
- 3. Students will not be allowed to take classes if fees are not paid. (Fees are due on the first of each month or the beginning of each term)
- 4. Dance Bahamas will not be held responsible for items lost or stolen. Students are advised to leave personal items at home.
- 5. Students must remove street shoes before entering the studio.
- 6. Students are not allowed to eat in the waiting area, studio and the changing room.
- 7. There will be no GUM chewing.
- 8. All students must have their names printed on all dance attire.
- 9. Students must be properly attired for all classes, they are required to wear assigned class colours at all times. (Please refer to proper dance attire listed.)
- 10. Students with **RUNS or HOLES** in tights will not be allowed in class.
- 11. No jewellery is allowed in class; special permission will be granted for religious or medical reasons only.
- 12. Students must be properly groomed for classes. Girls with long hair must arrange their hair in a neat bun or tie in back neatly.
- 13. Students who are disruptive in class will be asked to sit on the side.
- 14. SMOKING is strictly prohibited.
- 15. Students must enter and leave the studio in a quiet and orderly manner.
- 16. Parents are asked to collect their child/children promptly after class. A **\$20** fee will be charged for the care and supervision of all students who remain on the premises 30 minutes after class has ended.
